An Act to make supplementary provision to meet additional expenditure for the financial year 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act is the Supplementary Supply (FY 2023) Act 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, “FY 2023” means the period starting 1 April 2023 and ending 31 March 2024.

Supplementary supply from Consolidated Fund

3.—(1) A further sum of not more than \$10,481,489,700, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 2023, is authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for FY 2023.

(2) The sum in subsection (1) is appropriated for the Heads of Expenditure for the public service specified in the Schedule.

Supplementary supply from Development Fund

4.—(1) A further sum of not more than \$772,939,200, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 2023, is authorised to be issued from the Development Fund for FY 2023.

(2) The sum in subsection (1) is appropriated for development purposes under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.
