### **PREVENTION OF POLLUTION OF THE SEA ACT 1990**

#### **PREVENTION OF POLLUTION OF THE SEA (BALLAST WATER MANAGEMENT) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2022**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34(1) of the Prevention of Pollution of the Sea Act 1990, the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore, with the approval of the Minister for Transport, makes the following Regulations:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Prevention of Pollution of the Sea (Ballast Water Management) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2022 and come into operation on 1 January 2023.

#### **Amendment of regulation 2**

2. In regulation 2 of the Prevention of Pollution of the Sea (Ballast Water Management) Regulations 2017 (G.N. No. S 504/2017) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations), after the definition of “gross tonnage”, insert —

““GST” means the goods and services tax chargeable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1993;”.

#### **Replacement of regulation 17 and new regulation 18**

3. In the principal Regulations, replace regulation 17 with —

##### **“Fees**

17.—(1) The fees specified in the second column of the Fourth Schedule are payable to the Director for the services specified opposite in the first column of that Schedule.

(2) Where GST is chargeable on any supply of services specified in the first column of the Fourth Schedule, GST is calculated based on the rate in force at the time the services are supplied.

### **Partial waiver in 2023 due to increase in GST**

**18.** In respect of the fee for any supply of services specified in the first column of the Fourth Schedule that is chargeable with GST, an amount equivalent to 1% of the fee (exclusive of GST) is waived for the period between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2023 (both dates inclusive).”.

### **Amendment of Fourth Schedule**

**4.** In the Fourth Schedule to the principal Regulations —

(a) replace the Schedule reference with —

“Regulations 17 and 18”; and

(b) in item 5, in the second column, replace “\$14” with “\$15.12 (inclusive of GST)”.
