ACTIVE MOBILITY (MANDATORY TESTING — MOTORISED PMD WITH HANDLEBARS) ORDER 2020

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

1. Citation and commencement
 2. Start date for mandatory testing
 3. Periodic testing
 4. Testing not needed for deregistered PMD

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 35A of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Active Mobility (Mandatory Testing — Motorised PMD with Handlebars) Order 2020 and comes into operation on 3 April 2020.

Start date for mandatory testing

2. Starting 3 April 2020, for the purposes of Division 2 of Part 4 of the Act, an inspection is required for and in respect of every motorised personal mobility device that —

- (a) has an electric motor attached to the device; and
- (b) has handlebars.

Periodic testing

3. The inspection for and in respect of every motorised personal mobility device mentioned in paragraph 2 is a periodic inspection that, subject to paragraph 4, must be carried out before the end of every 2 years after the last certification of inspection —

- (a) issued under section 35C of the Act with respect to that motorised personal mobility device; and
- (b) not cancelled or expired.

Testing not needed for deregistered PMD

4. However, no periodic inspection is required in respect of a motorised personal mobility device mentioned in paragraph 2 if its registration is cancelled under section 28D of the Act.
