ORDER 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 63 of the Corruption, Drug Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (Confiscation of Benefits) Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Corruption, Drug Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (Confiscation of Benefits) Act (Amendment of Second Schedule) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 31 July 2017.

**Amendment of Second Schedule**

2. The Second Schedule to the Corruption, Drug Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (Confiscation of Benefits) Act is amended by inserting, immediately after the *Note* to Part XVI, the following Part:

*“Part XVII – Offences included as serious offences  
with effect from 31 July 2017*

<i>Offences</i>	<i>Description *</i>
<b>Computer Misuse and Cybersecurity Act (Cap. 50A)</b>	
442. Section 8A	Supplying, etc., personal information obtained in contravention of certain provisions
443. Section 8B	Obtaining, etc., items for use in certain offences

*\*Note: The short description of offences is for ease of reference only.”.*
