(CHAPTER 257A)**

**PUBLIC ORDER  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Amendment) Regulations 2020 and come into operation on 26 June 2020.

**Deletion and substitution of regulation 2**

2. Regulation 2 of the Public Order Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 487/2009) is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

**“Non-application to election meetings and processions**

2. These Regulations do not apply to any public assembly or public procession to which either of the following Regulations apply:

- (a) the Public Order (Election Meetings and Processions in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 486/2009);
- (b) the Public Order (Election Meetings and Processions in Presidential Elections) Regulations 2017 (G.N. No. S 273/2017).”.

**Amendment of regulations 4 and 11**
