ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1961

ROAD TRAFFIC (ELECTRONIC ROAD PRICING SYSTEM) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34D of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) (Amendment) Rules 2023 and come into operation on 13 February 2023.

Amendment of First Schedule

2. In the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2015 (G.N. No. S 226/2015), in the First Schedule —
