CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE  
(RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PRIME MINISTER)  
(AMENDMENT) NOTIFICATION 2017

**Variation of Responsibility of Prime Minister**

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, varied with effect from 1 May 2017, the Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Prime Minister) Notification 2015 (G.N. No. S 653/2015) —

- (a) by inserting, immediately after item 5 under the heading “DEPARTMENTS AND STATUTORY BODIES”, the following item:
  - “5A. Government Technology Agency”;
- (b) by deleting item 16 under the heading “DEPARTMENTS AND STATUTORY BODIES” and substituting the following item:
  - “16. Smart Nation and Digital Government Office”; and
- (c) by inserting, immediately after item 20 under the heading “SUBJECTS”, the following items:
  - “20A. Digital Government
  - 20B. Public Sector Data Governance
  - 20C. Public Sector Info-communications Technology and Related Engineering”.
