In exercise of the powers conferred by section 46(2) of the Interpretation Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order is the Interpretation (Temporary Reduction of Electronic Road Pricing System Charges) Order 2020.

**Temporary reduction of charges**

2. For the period 23 November 2020 to 31 December 2020 (both dates inclusive), the road-user charges payable under the First Schedule to the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2015 (G.N. No. S 226/2015) (called the principal Rules) in respect of any motor vehicle ridden, driven or moved into a specified entry point on a specified road set out in the First to the Fourth Schedules are reduced wholly or in part at the times and to the extent specified in the second column of those Schedules.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

## WHOLE REDUCTION OF CHARGES

1. Central Expressway 2 in Part 1	From 8 a.m. but before 8.30 a.m.

3. Pan-Island Expressway — Central Expressway Slip Road in Part 5	From 9 a.m. but before 9.30 a.m.
