In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11(1) of the Public Entertainments and Meetings Act, the Minister for Communications and Information hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification may be cited as the Public Entertainments (Security) (Arts Entertainment Licensing Officer) Notification 2014 and shall come into operation on 1 January 2015.

Security under section 11(1) of Act

2.—(1) The Arts Entertainment Licensing Officer may, under section 11(1) of the Act, require security to be given in respect of any class of arts entertainment specified in the first column of the Schedule.

(2) The amount of security required under section 11(1) of the Act in respect of that class of arts entertainment must not exceed the amount specified for it in the second column of the Schedule.

SECURITY FOR ARTS ENTERTAINMENTS REGULATED BY ARTS
ENTERTAINMENT LICENSING OFFICER

<i>First column</i>	<i>Second column</i>
1. Plays, operas or pantomimes	\$10,000 per licence
2. Variety acts or performances of music, singing or dancing	\$10,000 per licence
3. Displays or exhibitions using real-time transmission of the performance happening elsewhere (whether in or outside Singapore and whether in a public or private place) of any arts entertainment, or any combination of arts entertainments, specified in items 1 and 2	\$10,000 per licence
