- 1. This Act may be cited as the Voluntary Conveyances short title. Act.
- 2. In this Act, "conveyance" includes every mode of Interpredisposition mentioned or referred to in the Imperial Act 27 Elizabeth 1, c. 4.
- 3. Subject to section 4, no voluntary conveyance of any voluntary immovable property, whether made before or after 8th conveyances October 1915, if in fact made bona fide and without any fraudulent intent, shall hereafter be deemed fraudulent or covinous within the meaning of the Imperial Act 27 Elizabeth 1, c. 4 by reason of any subsequent purchase for ²⁷ Eliz. 1, value, or be defeated under any of the provisions of that Act by a conveyance made upon such purchase, any rule of law notwithstanding.

This Act shall not apply in any case in which the author saving as to of a voluntary conveyance of any immovable property has transactions completed subsequently to the conveyance but before 8th October before 8th 1915 disposed of or dealt with that immovable property to October or in favour of a purchaser for value.
