An Act to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund and the Development Fund of the sums necessary to meet the estimated expenditure for the financial year 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

### Short title and commencement

1. This Act is the Supply Act 2020 and comes into operation on 1 April 2020.

### Supply from Consolidated Fund

2.—(1) A sum not more than \$108,398,100,400 is authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the period starting 1 April 2020 and ending 31 March 2021.

(2) The sum in subsection (1) is appropriated for the Heads of Expenditure for the public service specified in the Schedule.

### Supply from Development Fund

3.—(1) A sum not more than \$32,539,083,600 is authorised to be issued from the Development Fund for the period starting 1 April 2020 and ending 31 March 2021.

(2) The sum in subsection (1) is appropriated for development purposes under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.
