An Act to provide for making supplementary provision to meet additional expenditure for the financial year 1st April 2013 to 31st March 2014.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Supply (FY 2013) Act 2014.

Supplementary supply from Consolidated Fund

2.—(1) A further sum of \$318,452,700, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 2013 (Act 8 of 2013), is hereby authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the period from 1st April 2013 to 31st March 2014.

(2) The sum specified in subsection (1) is hereby appropriated for the several Heads of Expenditure for the public service specified in the Schedule.

Supplementary supply from Development Fund

3.—(1) A further sum of \$1,674,209,500, not otherwise provided for by the Supply Act 2013, is hereby authorised to be issued from the Development Fund for the period from 1st April 2013 to 31st March 2014.

(2) The sum specified in subsection (1) is hereby appropriated for development purposes under the several Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule.
