A BILL

An Act to amend the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) Act 1955.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act is the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Act 2024 and comes into operation on 21 October 2024.

5 Amendment of section 1

- **2.** In the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) Act 1955, in section 1, replace subsection (2) with
 - "(2) This Act continues in force for a period of 5 years starting on 21 October 2024.".

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to amend the Criminal Law (Temporary Provisions) Act 1955 (the Act).

Clause 1 relates to the short title and commencement.

Clause 2 amends section 1 to extend the operation of the Act for a further period of 5 years starting on 21 October 2024.

EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC MONEY

This Bill will not involve the Government in any extra financial expenditure.
