An Act to amend the Criminal Procedure Code (Chapter 132 of the Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment No. 2) Act, 1967.

Amendment of section 368

5 **2.** Section 368 of the Criminal Procedure Code is hereby amended
by deleting the words “fifty dollars and in default of payment to
imprisonment for a term which may extend to two months unless
such fine is sooner paid” appearing therein and substituting therefor
10 the words “five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for a term not
exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to amend section 368 of the Criminal Procedure Code so as to increase the powers of a subordinate court in regard to sentence when exercising its jurisdiction under the said section.

EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC MONEY

This Bill will not involve the Government in any extra financial expenditure.
