ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS ACT 2010 (AMENDMENT OF THIRD SCHEDULE) ORDER 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 21(3) of the Electronic Transactions Act 2010, the Minister for Digital Development and Information makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Electronic Transactions Act 2010 (Amendment of Third Schedule) Order 2025 and comes into operation on 8 January 2025.

Amendment of Third Schedule

2. In the Electronic Transactions Act 2010, in the Third Schedule —

(a) in paragraph 1(1), after the definition of “private key”, insert —

““public certification authority” means a public agency that is approved by the Minister under paragraph 3(b)(iii) to act as a certification authority;”;

(b) in paragraphs 4 and 11, after “an accredited certification authority” wherever it appears, insert “, a public certification authority”;

(c) in paragraph 10(1), after “An accredited certification authority”, insert “, a public certification authority”;

(d) in paragraphs 10(2) and 11(a) and (b)(i), after “accredited certification authority”, insert “, public certification authority”; and

(e) in paragraph 11, in the paragraph heading, after “authorities”, insert “, etc.”.
