COPYRIGHT ACT (CHAPTER 63)

COPYRIGHT TRIBUNALS (PROCEDURE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 175 and 202 of the Copyright Act, the Minister for Law makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Copyright Tribunals (Procedure) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 and come into operation on 2 January 2021.

Miscellaneous amendments

2. The Copyright Tribunals (Procedure) Regulations (Rg 6) are amended —

(a) by deleting the words “High Court” wherever they appear in the following provisions and substituting in each case the words “General Division of the High Court”:

Regulation 44(5)

Regulation 47(1)

Regulation 49

Regulation 50(1)

Regulation 51(1), (2) and (3);

(b) by deleting the words “THE HIGH COURT” in the following provision and substituting the words “GENERAL DIVISION OF HIGH COURT”:

Part VIII (Part heading);

(c) by deleting the words “the Court” wherever they appear in the following provision and substituting in each case the words “the General Division of the High Court”.

Regulation 51(1); and

(d) by deleting the words “High Court” in the regulation heading of the following provisions and substituting in each case the words “General Division of High Court”:

Regulation 47

Regulation 49

Regulation 50

Regulation 51.
