CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE (CHAPTER 68)

CRIMINAL PROCEDURE (AMENDMENT) RULES 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 428A(15) of the Criminal Procedure Code, the Minister for Law makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Rules 2020 and come into operation on 2 January 2021.

Miscellaneous amendments

2. The Schedule to the Criminal Procedure Rules 2018 (G.N. No. S 727/2018) is amended —

(a) by deleting the words “High Court” wherever they appear in the following Forms and substituting in each case the words “General Division of the High Court”:

Forms 20, 37, 46, 47, 50, 51, 53, 55, 56, 68 and 77;

(b) by deleting the words “said Court” wherever they appear in the following Forms and substituting in each case the words “General Division of the High Court”:

Forms 20 and 47;

(c) by deleting the words “HIGH COURT” in the following Forms and substituting in each case the words “GENERAL DIVISION OF HIGH COURT”:

Forms 42, 48 and 53;

(d) by deleting the words “the High Court” in the following Form and substituting the words “the General Division of the High Court”:

Form 52;

(e) by deleting the words “*Judge of Appeal/High Court Judge**” in the following Form and substituting the words “*Justice of the Court of Appeal/Judge of the Appellate Division/Judge of the High Court**”:

Form 52;

(f) by deleting the words “Judge of Appeal” wherever they appear in the following Forms and substituting in each case the words “Justice of the Court of Appeal”:

Forms 55 and 56; and

(g) by deleting the words “HIGH COURT” in the following Forms and substituting in each case the words “GENERAL DIVISION OF THE HIGH COURT”:

Forms 66, 67, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75 and 76.
