### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

#### ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR VEHICLES, LIGHTING) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Act, the Land Transport Authority of Singapore makes the following Rules:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Lighting) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2021 and come into operation on 3 January 2022.

#### **Amendment of rule 11**

2. Rule 11 of the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Lighting) Rules (R 10) is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “a motor vehicle used for fire brigade, ambulance” in paragraph (1) and substituting the words “an authorised ambulance or a motor vehicle used for fire brigade”;
- (b) by inserting, immediately after the words “when the vehicle is being used” in paragraph (4), the words “for a medical emergency or”; and
- (c) by inserting, immediately after paragraph (4), the following paragraph:

“(5) In this rule —

“ambulance” means a motor vehicle that is specifically equipped for —

- (a) the transport on roads of; and

(b) the provision, during such transport, of out-of-hospital clinical care to, sick or injured individuals who require emergency medical treatment;

“authorised”, for an ambulance, means —

(a) being specified in a licence (other than a revoked licence) under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 authorising the use of the ambulance to provide a licensable healthcare service specified in that licence; or

(b) being owned by the Government and used for the purposes of the Singapore Armed Forces or the Singapore Civil Defence Force.”.
