# ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

# ROAD TRAFFIC (PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 121 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Rules:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Rules are the Road Traffic (Pedestrian Crossings) (Amendment) Rules 2021 and come into operation on 3 January 2022.

#### Amendment of rule 2

- **2.** Rule 2 of the Road Traffic (Pedestrian Crossings) Rules (R 24) is amended by inserting, immediately before the definition of "bicycle", the following definitions:
  - ""ambulance" means a motor vehicle that is specifically equipped for
    - (a) the transport on roads of; and
    - (b) the provision, during such transport, of out-of-hospital clinical care to,

sick or injured individuals who require emergency medical treatment;

"authorised", for an ambulance, means —

- (a) being specified in a licence (other than a revoked licence) under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 authorising the use of the ambulance to provide a licensable healthcare service specified in that licence; or
- (b) being owned by the Government and used for the purposes of the Singapore Armed Forces or the Singapore Civil Defence Force;".

# Amendment of rule 10

- **3.** Rule 10(2) of the Road Traffic (Pedestrian Crossings) Rules is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (i) of sub-paragraph (c) and substituting the following sub-paragraphs:
  - "(i) for fire service or police purposes;
  - (ia) if the vehicle is an authorised ambulance to attend to a medical emergency;".
