CUSTOMS ACT (CHAPTER 70)

CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 143(1) of the Customs Act, the Minister for Finance makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Customs (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 1 January 2022.

Amendment of Third Schedule

- **2.** Item 2 of the Third Schedule to the Customs Regulations (Rg 2) is amended
 - (a) by deleting "\$43,200" in paragraph (a)(i) and substituting "\$31,600"; and
 - (b) by deleting paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:
 - "(*b*) to distill. ferment, or manufacture any other intoxicating liquors, where the projected annual production volume (in the case of an application for the issue of a licence) or the annual production past volume (in the case of an application for renewal of a licence) is —
 - (i) 400,000 litres or more

\$23,500 for one year

(ii) less than 400,000 litres \$10,200 for one year".
