ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

ROAD TRAFFIC (MOTOR VEHICLES, REGISTRATION AND LICENSING) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) RULES 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 34 and 140 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) (Amendment No. 4) Rules 2020 and come into operation on 30 December 2020.

Amendment of rule 10

2. Rule 10 of the Road Traffic (Motor Vehicles, Registration and Licensing) Rules (R 5) is amended —

(a) by deleting the words “on or after 1 January 2018” in paragraph (1)(a)(i) and (ii) and substituting in each case the words “between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2022 (both dates inclusive)”;

(b) by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(2) Subject to paragraphs (6) and (7), the amount of the rebate which the Registrar may grant upon an application under paragraph (1) is as follows:

(a) where the emission level of any of the prescribed vehicular emissions from the vehicle falls within Band A2 for that emission —

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- (i) for a vehicle first registered as a motor car (other than a taxi) between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2020 (both dates inclusive) — \$10,000;
 - (ii) for a vehicle first registered as a motor car (other than a taxi) between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2022 (both dates inclusive) — \$15,000;
 - (iii) for a vehicle first registered as a taxi between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2020 (both dates inclusive) — \$15,000; and
 - (iv) for a vehicle first registered as a taxi between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2022 (both dates inclusive) — \$22,500;
- (b) where none of the emission levels of any of the prescribed vehicular emissions from the vehicle fall within Band A2 for that emission —
- (i) for a vehicle first registered as a motor car (other than a taxi) between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2020 (both dates inclusive) — \$20,000;
 - (ii) for a vehicle first registered as a motor car (other than a taxi) between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2022 (both dates inclusive) — \$25,000;
 - (iii) for a vehicle first registered as a taxi between 1 January 2018 and

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- 31 December 2020 (both dates inclusive) — \$30,000; and
- (iv) for a vehicle first registered as a taxi between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2022 (both dates inclusive) — \$37,500.”; and
- (c) by deleting the words “on or after 1 January 2018” in the rule heading and substituting the words “between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2022”.
