SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE ACT (AMENDMENT OF SIXTH SCHEDULE) ORDER 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 83(1) of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, the Minister for Law, after consulting the Chief Justice, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Supreme Court of Judicature Act (Amendment of Sixth Schedule) Order 2020 and comes into operation on 2 January 2021 at 12.01 a.m.

Amendment of Sixth Schedule

2. Paragraph 1 of the Sixth Schedule to the Supreme Court of Judicature Act is amended by deleting the full-stop at the end of sub-paragraph (j) and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following sub-paragraphs:

- “(k) the appeal is against a decision or an order of the General Division under the Mediation Act 2017 (Act 1 of 2017), including a decision of the General Division to record or refuse to record a mediated settlement agreement as an order of court under that Act;
- (l) the appeal is against a decision or an order of the General Division under the Singapore Convention on Mediation Act 2020 (Act 4 of 2020), including a decision of the General Division granting leave or refusing to grant leave to record an international settlement agreement as an order of court under that Act.”.
