COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 2) NOTIFICATION 2019

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 2) Notification 2019.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister exempts the National Service Resort & Country Club (called in this Notification the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the “NSRCC Charity Golf 2019” event to be held from 25 February 2019 to 5 May 2019 (both dates inclusive); and
- (b) the draw to be held at 8 p.m. on 5 May 2019 at the ballroom of the National Service Resort & Country Club at Changi.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2(2)

CONDITIONS

1. The price of the draw ticket, the name of the organiser, and the details of the prizes to be distributed, must be clearly stated on each draw ticket.
2. The draw ticket must only be issued by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
3. The name, identity card number (if available) and contact number of the purchaser of each draw ticket must be recorded on the counterfoil of that ticket.
4. The draw must be conducted in public by the organiser and persons in the employment of the organiser.
5. The draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act to be a lottery or a game of chance or of mixed chance and skill.
6. The draw must not involve the use of any article declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act to be an instrument or appliance for gaming.
7. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that the results of the draw must be published in one major daily newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners.
8. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draw are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 6 August 2019.
