PROTECTED PLACES (NO. 4) ORDER 2001

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(1) of the Protected Areas and Protected Places Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Places (No. 4) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on 16th March 2001.

Premises declared to be protected place

2. The premises described in the second column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be a protected place for the purposes of the Act, and no person shall be in those premises unless he is in possession of a pass-card or permit issued by the authority specified in the first column of the Schedule or has received the permission of an authorised officer on duty at the premises to enter the premises.

All that area comprised in part of Lot 1781T MUKIM No. 29 (TAMPINES) occupied by "PASIR RIS CAMP" containing an area of about 160,432 square metres and bounded approximately as follows:

Commencing at a point on the northernmost corner of the aforesaid "PASIR RIS CAMP" which point is 41,985.764 metres North and 39,273.208 metres East of the Survey Department origin of co-ordinates (30,000 metres North, 30,000 metres East), the boundaries run along successive plot boundary lines of bearings and distances approximately as under:

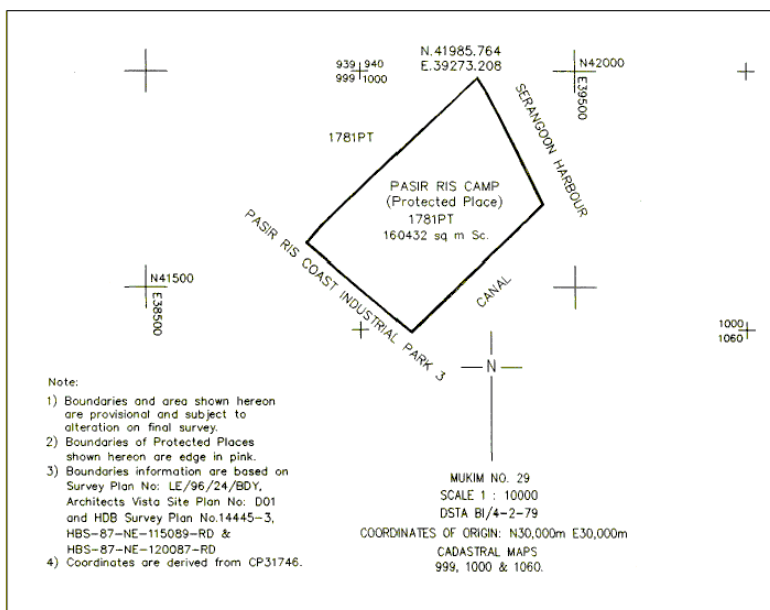
