# CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) NOTIFICATION 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 30 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister makes the following Notification:

### Citation and commencement

1. This Notification is the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) (Amendment No. 2) Notification 2023 and comes into operation on 1 April 2023.

### Amendment of Seventh Schedule

- **2.** In the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 723/2020), in the Seventh Schedule
  - (a) under the heading "**Departments**", replace item 3 with "3. Accounting Standards Committee";
  - (b) under the heading "Departments", delete item 6; and
  - (c) under the heading "Subjects", in item 7(3), delete sub-paragraph (a).
