COMMON GAMING HOUSES (NATIONAL SERVICE RESORT & COUNTRY CLUB — EXEMPTION) NOTIFICATION 2022

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act 1961, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (National Service Resort & Country Club — Exemption) Notification 2022.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister exempts the National Service Resort & Country Club (UEN 46304600E) (called in this Notification the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the “National Service Resort & Country Club Charity Golf 2022” promotion to be held from 4 March 2022 to 22 May 2022 (both dates inclusive); and
- (b) the draw to be held as part of the promotion at 8 p.m. on 22 May 2022 at the ballroom of the National Service Resort & Country Club at Changi.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2(2)

CONDITIONS

1. The price of the draw ticket, the name of the organiser, and the details of the prizes to be distributed, must be clearly stated on each draw ticket.
2. Each draw ticket must only be issued by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
3. The name, identity card number (if available) and contact number of the purchaser of each draw ticket must be recorded on the counterfoil of that draw ticket.
4. The draw must be conducted in public by the organiser and persons in the employment of the organiser.
5. The draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act to be a lottery or a game of chance or of mixed chance and skill.
6. The draw must not involve the use of any article declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act to be an instrument or appliance for gaming.
7. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that a notification of the win is sent to each winner of the draw by ordinary post.
8. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that the results of the draw are published in one major daily newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners.
9. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draw are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 23 August 2022.
