In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(4) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2020 and comes into operation on 12 March 2020.

**Prescribed date**

2. For the purposes of section 5(1), (1A) and (2) of the Act, the prescribed date is 1 March in any year instead of 1 July.

**Revocation**

3. The Parliamentary Elections (Prescribed Date) Order 2019 (G.N. No. S 78/2019) is revoked.
