# FINANCIAL PROCEDURE ACT (CHAPTER 109)

# FINANCIAL (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Financial Procedure Act, the Minister for Finance makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations are the Financial (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 23 March 2021.

### Amendment of regulation 2

- **2.** Regulation 2 of the Financial Regulations (Rg 1) is amended by deleting the definition of "Accounting Officer" and substituting the following definition:
  - ""Accounting Officer" means
    - (a) a Deputy Attorney-General;
    - (b) the Solicitor-General;
    - (c) the Auditor-General;
    - (d) the Clerk of Parliament;
    - (e) the Permanent Secretary of a Ministry;
    - (f) the Principal Private Secretary to the President;
    - (g) the Chief Executive, Office of the Chief Justice;
    - (h) the Principal District Judge (Corporate Services);
    - (i) the Chief Executive, Attorney-General's Chambers;

- (j) the Secretary to the Cabinet;
- (k) the Secretary to the Presidential Council;
- (1) the Secretary to the Prime Minister; or
- (m) the Secretary to the Public Service Commission;".
