### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1961

#### ROAD TRAFFIC (HELMET EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Helmet Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2024 and comes into operation on 1 March 2024.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 2**

2. In the Road Traffic (Helmet Exemption) Order 2005 (G.N. No. S 410/2005) —

- (a) renumber paragraph 2 as sub-paragraph (1) of that paragraph;
- (b) in paragraph 2(1), replace “(Bicycles)” with “(Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct)”;
- (c) in paragraph 2(1), after “on a bicycle”, insert “, three-wheeled pedal cycle, recumbent device”; and

(d) in paragraph 2, after sub-paragraph (1), insert —

“(2) In this Order, “recumbent device” and “three-wheeled pedal cycle” have the meanings given by rule 2 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Construction and Use) Rules 2024 (G.N. No. S 157/2024).”.
