### CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (RESPONSIBILITY OF THE MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY (INDUSTRY)) (AMENDMENT) NOTIFICATION 2018

#### **Variation of Responsibility of Minister for Trade and Industry (Industry)**

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, varied with effect from 1 April 2018, the Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Minister for Trade and Industry (Industry)) Notification 2015 (G.N. No. S 662/2015) —

- (a) by deleting item 4 under the heading “DEPARTMENTS AND STATUTORY BODIES” and substituting the following item:
  - “4. Enterprise Singapore Board”;
- (b) by deleting item 7 under the heading “DEPARTMENTS AND STATUTORY BODIES”; and
- (c) by deleting the words “Consumer Protection and Fair Trading” in item 2 under the heading “SUBJECTS” and substituting the words “Consumer Protection (Trade Descriptions and Safety Requirements)”.
