### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1961

#### ROAD TRAFFIC (NANYANG TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY — EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Nanyang Technological University — Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2024 and comes into operation on 1 March 2024.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 2**

2. In the Road Traffic (Nanyang Technological University — Exemption) Order 2024 (G.N. No. S 93/2024), in paragraph 2, in the definition of “specified rules”, in paragraph (b), replace “(Bicycles)” with “(Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct)”.

#### **Amendment of paragraph 3**

3. In the Road Traffic (Nanyang Technological University — Exemption) Order 2024, in paragraph 3(b)(i) —

- (a) replace “(Bicycles)” with “(Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct)”; and
- (b) after “(except rule 13(1))”, insert “and the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Construction and Use) Rules 2024 (G.N. No. S 157/2024)”.
