### HOUSE TO HOUSE AND STREET COLLECTIONS ACT (CHAPTER 128)

#### HOUSE TO HOUSE AND STREET COLLECTIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the House to House and Street Collections Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the House to House and Street Collections (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 30 June 2017.

#### **Amendment of regulation 12**

2. Regulation 12 of the House to House and Street Collections Regulations (Rg 1) is amended by deleting the words “2 months of” and substituting the words “60 days after”.

#### **Amendment of regulation 13**

3. Regulation 13 of the House to House and Street Collections Regulations is amended —

(a) by deleting “\$5,000” in paragraph (a)(i) and substituting “\$10,000”; and

(b) by deleting sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(ii) where the total amount of money collected, including the proceeds derived from the sale of property does not exceed \$10,000, be certified by an independent person

who is from among persons whom the Commissioner of Police determines to have the requisite ability and practical experience to carry out a competent examination, and who is appointed by the organisation of the chief promoter to be the auditor of the account; and”.
