In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and period in force**

1.—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (MetaSprint Series Singapore 2024 — Duathlon — Exemption) Order 2024.

(2) This Order is in force on 17 March 2024.

#### **Definitions**

2. In this Order —

“specified event” means the MetaSprint Series Singapore 2024 — Duathlon event organised by Tribob.com Pte. Ltd. on 17 March 2024;

“specified road” means any of the roads delineated by the black-coloured lines in the map set out in the Schedule;

“Tribob.com Pte. Ltd.” means the company incorporated under the Companies Act 1967 as Tribob.com Pte. Ltd. (UEN 200312749K).

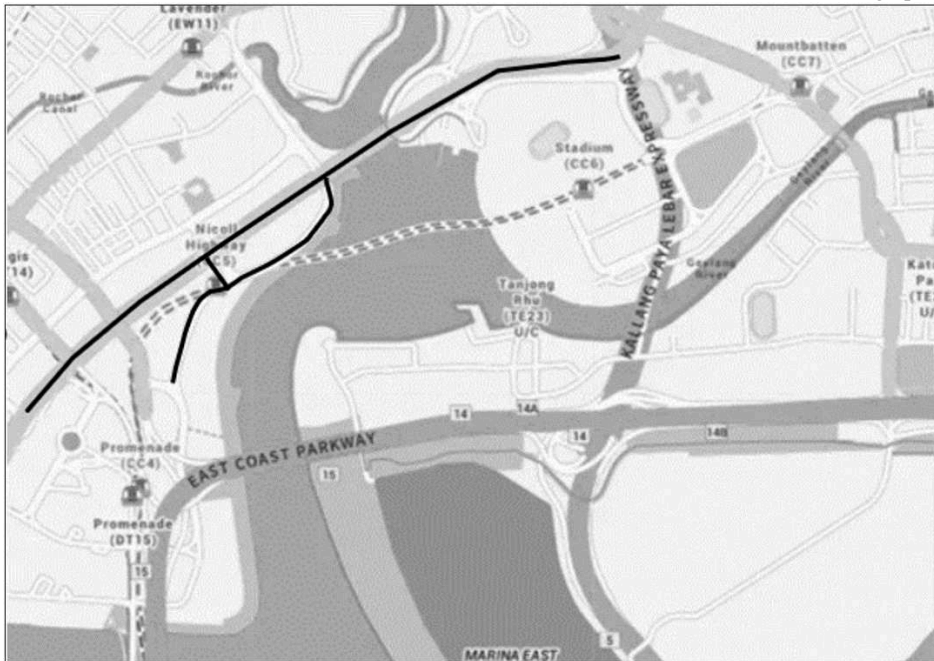
### **Exemption for riding bicycle**

**3.** Section 120(3) of the Act does not apply to an individual who rides a bicycle on a specified road during and in connection with the specified event under the following conditions:

- (a) the individual is registered with Tribob.com Pte. Ltd. as a participant of the specified event;
- (b) there is in force, at any time the bicycle is ridden in connection with the specified event, a policy of insurance in relation to the bicycle insuring against any liability in respect of —
  - (i) the death of or bodily injury sustained by any person (other than the rider of the bicycle); and
  - (ii) any property damage suffered by any person (other than the rider of the bicycle),caused by or arising out of the use of the bicycle;
- (c) the risk under the policy of insurance mentioned in sub-paragraph (b) is assumed by an insurer who, at the time the policy is issued, is lawfully carrying on an insurance business in Singapore.
