In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20(1) of the Protection from Harassment Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Protection from Harassment (Prescribed Internet Intermediaries and Others) Regulations 2020 and come into operation on 1 April 2020.

Disabling order

- **2.** For the purpose of section 15C(2)(b) of the Act, the prescribed internet intermediaries are as follows:

 - (b) Twitter, Inc., in respect of Twitter;

- (d) WeChat International Pte. Ltd., in respect of WeChat;
- (e) Google LLC, in respect of YouTube.

Targeted correction order

- **3.** For the purpose of section 15D(2)(b) of the Act, the prescribed internet intermediaries are as follows:
 - (a) Facebook, Inc., in respect of
 - (i) Facebook; and
 - (ii) Instagram;
 - (b) Twitter, Inc., in respect of Twitter;
 - (c) SPH Magazines Pte. Ltd., in respect of HardwareZone.com;
 - (d) WeChat International Pte. Ltd., in respect of WeChat;
 - (e) Google LLC, in respect of YouTube.

General correction order

- **4.**—(1) For the purposes of section 15E(2)(a) of the Act, the prescribed holder of a permit under section 21 of the Newspaper and Printing Presses Act (Cap. 206) is Singapore Press Holdings Limited.
- (2) For the purposes of section 15E(2)(b) of the Act, the prescribed broadcasting licensees within the meaning of the Broadcasting Act (Cap. 28) are as follows:
 - (a) Mediacorp Pte. Ltd.;
