COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 22) NOTIFICATION 2014

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 22) Notification 2014.

Exemption

- 2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "Guess & Win Facebook Online Contest" promotion to be held from 31st March 2014 to 25th April 2014 (both dates inclusive) and the draw to be held on 9th May 2014 at 4 p.m. at the Administration Building of the Singapore Racecourse.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
- 2. The draw shall be conducted by the Singapore Turf Club and its officers only.
- 3. The draw shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 4. The draw shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 5. The Singapore Turf Club shall undertake to ensure that
 - (a) the winners shall be notified by telephone or in writing by electronic means; and
 - (b) an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the draw, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 10th August 2014.
