In exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the Remote Gambling Act 2014, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Remote Gambling (Exemption) Order 2015.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Singapore Turf Club is exempt from sections 10, 11, 15 and 17 of the Act in respect of the “Vote for Your Favourite Turf Belle” promotion to be held from 23 April 2015 to 11 May 2015 (both dates inclusive) on the website known as Singapore Turf Club Facebook Fan Page at <http://www.facebook.com/SGTurfClub>.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, where the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, must be disclosed in publicity material, copies of which must be freely accessible to all participants.
2. The draw must —
 - (a) be conducted in public; or
 - (b) if conducted in private by means of a computerised system, be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of the Singapore Turf Club.
3. The Singapore Turf Club must undertake to ensure that —
 - (a) every winner is notified in writing by electronic means; and
 - (b) the results of the draw are published on both of the following websites:
 - (i) the Singapore Turf Club Facebook Fan Page at <http://www.facebook.com/SGTurfClub>;
 - (ii) the Singapore Airlines International Cup website at <http://www.siacup.sg>.
4. The Singapore Turf Club must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draw are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 19 August 2015.
