ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT (CHAPTER 6B)

ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS (REGISTRATION AND PRACTISING CERTIFICATES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 75 of the Allied Health Professions Act, the Allied Health Professions Council, with the approval of the Minister for Health, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Allied Health Professions (Registration and Practising Certificates) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2016 and come into operation on 1 June 2016.

Amendment of Part I of First Schedule

2. Division 2 of Part I of the First Schedule to the Allied Health Professions (Registration and Practising Certificates) Regulations 2013 (G.N. No. S 219/2013) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after item 6 relating to the country “Australia”, the following item:

“ 6A. Curtin University of Technology Master of Occupational Therapy ”;

(b) by inserting, immediately after item 8 relating to the country “Australia”, the following items:

“ 8A. La Trobe University Master of Occupational Therapy Practice ”

8B.	La Trobe University	Bachelor of Health Science and Master of Occupational Therapy Practice	
8C.	La Trobe University	Bachelor of Applied Science and Master of Occupational Therapy Practice	”;

(c) by inserting, immediately after item 10 relating to the country “Australia”, the following item:

“	10A.	The University of Queensland	Master of Occupational Therapy Studies	”;

(d) by inserting, immediately after item 12 relating to the country “Australia”, the following item:

“	12A.	University of South Australia	Master of Occupational Therapy	”; and

(e) by inserting, immediately after item 14 relating to the country “Australia”, the following item:

“	14A.	The University of Sydney	Master of Occupational Therapy	”.

Amendment of Part II of First Schedule

Queensland Studies”.

Amendment of Part III of First Schedule

4. Division 2 of Part III of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by inserting, immediately after item 12 relating to the country “Australia”, the following items:

“ 12A. La Trobe University Master of Speech Pathology
12B. La Trobe University Bachelor of Health Science and Master of
Speech Pathology
12C. La Trobe University Bachelor of Applied Science and Master
of Speech Pathology”.
