# CORONERS (MINISTER'S CERTIFICATE) REGULATIONS 2023

#### ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

## Regulation

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Request for Minister's certificate

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 49 of the Coroners Act 2010, the Minister for Law makes the following Regulations:

# Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations are the Coroners (Minister's Certificate) Regulations 2023 and come into operation on 2 May 2023.

# Request for Minister's certificate

- **2.**—(1) For the purpose of section 17A(1)(b) of the Act, a foreign State's request for a Minister's certificate to be issued must
  - (a) be made by a diplomatic agent of the foreign State or a consular officer of the foreign State;
  - (b) be sent
    - (i) by hand to the office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, 1 Sherwood Road, Tanglin, Singapore 248163; or
    - (ii) by email to mfa\_duty\_officer@mfa.gov.sg; and
  - (c) include the information mentioned in paragraph (2).
  - (2) The foreign State's request must include
    - (a) the deceased's name, nationality and passport number or foreign identification number;

- (b) the name, designation and contact details of the diplomatic agent or consular officer making the request;
- (c) a statement of
  - (i) which provision of section 17A(1)(a) of the Act the foreign State considers is applicable in respect of the deceased; and
  - (ii) the reasons for requesting the release of the deceased's body; and
- (d) any supporting document for the statement mentioned in sub-paragraph (c).
