## EVIDENCE (RESTRICTIONS ON QUESTIONS AND EVIDENCE IN CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2022

## Citation and commencement

**1.** These Rules are the Evidence (Restrictions on Questions and Evidence in Criminal Proceedings) (Amendment) Rules 2022 and come into operation on 1 April 2022.
