**ROAD TRAFFIC  
(INTERNATIONAL CIRCULATION)  
(AMENDMENT) RULES 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (International Circulation) (Amendment) Rules 2020 and are deemed to have come into operation on 18 March 2020.

**Amendment of rule 20E**

2. Rule 20E of the Road Traffic (International Circulation) Rules (R 7) is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (1B), the following paragraph:

“(1C) For the purpose of counting the number of days under paragraph (1A), if a vehicle remains in Singapore during the period between 18 March 2020 and 14 April 2020 (both dates inclusive), that period must be disregarded.”.
