# COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES) ACT 2020 (ACT 14 OF 2020)

# COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES) (PERFORMANCES AND OTHER ACTIVITIES — CONTROL ORDER) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34(1) of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations are the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Performances and Other Activities — Control Order) (Amendment No. 4) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 8 May 2021.

#### New regulation 4A

**2.** Part 2 of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Performances and Other Activities — Control Order) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 927/2020) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by inserting, immediately before regulation 5, the following regulation:

## "Approval needed for live performance

**4A.** A person staging a live performance that —

- (a) is staged on or after 8 May 2021;
- (b) is not a rehearsal; and

(c) is attended or likely to be attended by more than 50 seated audience members at the same time in a single undivided enclosed or unenclosed space in a live performance venue,

must not intentionally or negligently cause or allow the live performance to take place without the prior approval of the approving authority.".

#### Amendment of regulation 13

**3.** Regulation 13(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting "750" in sub-paragraph (a)(i) and substituting "250".

## Amendment of regulation 14

**4.** Regulation 14(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting "8" in sub-paragraph (*a*) and substituting "5".
