COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 22) NOTIFICATION 2012

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

Paragraph

- 2. Exemption The Schedule

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 22) Notification 2012.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (*a*) the "Match & Win Customer Promotion" to be held from 4th July 2012 to 30th November 2012 (both dates inclusive) (referred to in this paragraph as the relevant period); and
- (*b*) the lotteries to be held, as part of the "Match & Win Customer Promotion" during the relevant period.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Every lottery shall be conducted by the Singapore Turf Club and its officers only.
- 3. Every lottery by means of a computerised system which is not conducted in public shall be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not an employee of the Singapore Turf Club.
- 4. Every lottery shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 5. Every lottery shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 6. The Singapore Turf Club shall undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the lotteries, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 1st February 2013.
