PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT 1954

PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS (ELECTRONIC APPLICATIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 102 of the Parliamentary Elections Act 1954, the Prime Minister makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Parliamentary Elections (Electronic Applications) (Amendment) Regulations 2023 and come into operation on 1 June 2023.

Amendment of regulation 2

2. In the Parliamentary Elections (Electronic Applications) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 96/2009), in regulation 2 —

(a) replace the regulation heading with —

“Definitions”;

(b) in the definition of “appropriate form”, in paragraph (a), replace “11 Prinsep Link, Singapore 187949” with “11 Novena Rise, Singapore 307516”; and

(c) in the definition of “appropriate form”, in paragraph (b), replace “<http://www.eld.gov.sg>” with “<https://www.eld.gov.sg>”.

Deletion of regulation 5

3. In the Parliamentary Elections (Electronic Applications) Regulations 2009, delete regulation 5.
