# Citation and period in force

- **1.**—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Thaipusam Chariot Procession Exemption) Order 2022.
  - (2) This Order is in force on 17 January 2022 from 4 a.m. to 7 p.m.

### **Definitions**

- 2. In this Order
  - "chariot" means the vehicles bearing the vehicle registration numbers YM7452T and YG5292H;
  - "Chettiars' Temple Society" means the society registered under the Societies Act 1966 as Chettiars' Temple Society (UEN T04SS0015B);
  - "specified footway" means the part of the footway along New Bridge Road adjacent to the ERP gantry at New Bridge Road

that is delineated by the black-coloured line in the map set out in the Schedule;

"Thaipusam Chariot Procession" means the event organised by Chettiars' Temple Society on 17 January 2022.


# **Exemption**

**3.** Rule 28(1) of the Road Traffic Rules (R 20) does not apply to the driving of the chariot, for the purpose of the Thaipusam Chariot Procession, on the specified footway.
