In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) (Exemption) Order 2015.

Definitions

2. In this Order —

“restricted hours”, “specified entry point” and “specified road” have the same meanings as in the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2015 (G.N. No. S 226/2015);

“specified omnibus” means any omnibus registered in the name of SBS Transit Ltd that bears bus service number 70, 107, 128, 130, 133 or 162.

Exemption

3. Rule 5 of the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2015 (G.N. No. S 226/2015) does not apply to any specified omnibus that is driven or moved into the specified entry point on the specified road referred to in item 1 of Division 1 of Part 7 of the First Schedule to those Rules.

Revocation

4. The Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) (Exemption) Order 2007 (G.N. No. S 3/2007) is revoked.
