# COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 39) NOTIFICATION 2014

### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

### Citation

**1.** This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 39) Notification 2014.

### Exemption

**2.**—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Singapore Pools (Private) Limited from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "World Cup Draw 2014" promotion to be held from 13th June 2014 to 14th July 2014 (both dates inclusive) and the draw to be held on 31st July 2014 at 10 a.m. at the Head Office of Singapore Pools (Private) Limited.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

## THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

#### CONDITIONS

- 1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
- 2. The draw shall be conducted by Singapore Pools (Private) Limited and its officers only.
- 3. The draw shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 4. The draw shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 5. Singapore Pools (Private) Limited shall undertake to ensure that
  - (a) the winners shall be notified by telephone and in writing by electronic means;
  - (*b*) the results of the draw will be published in one major daily newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners; and
  - (c) an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the draw, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 1st November 2014.
