PINGAT PERTAHANAN (THE DEFENCE MEDAL)  
(AMENDMENT) RULES 1999

The President hereby makes the following Rules:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Pingat Pertahanan (The Defence Medal) (Amendment) Rules 1999 and shall come into operation on 1st September 2012.

**Deletion and substitution of rule 10**

2. Rule 10 of the Pingat Pertahanan (The Defence Medal) Rules 1970 (G.N. No.S200/70) is deleted and the following rule substituted therefor:

“10.— The awarding authority under rule 8 may forfeit any Medal awarded to any person under these Rules if he —

- (a) is convicted of any criminal offence;
- (b) is dismissed or removed from any uniformed organisation referred to in rule 6; or
- (c) is guilty of misconduct or disloyalty to Singapore.

(2) Any Medal so forfeited may be restored by the awarding authority at his discretion.

(3) A notice of the forfeiture or restoration of any Medal shall be published in the Orders of the respective uniformed organisations.”.
