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ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH ACT (CHAPTER 95)

ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH (PUBLIC CLEANSING) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 111 of the Environmental Public Health Act, the National Environment Agency, with the approval of the Minister for the Environment and Water Resources, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Environmental Public Health (Public Cleansing) (Amendment) Regulations 2016 and come into operation on 1 September 2016.

Amendment of Second Schedule

- **2.** The Second Schedule to the Environmental Public Health (Public Cleansing) Regulations (Rg 3) is amended
 - (a) by deleting sub-paragraphs (2) and (3) of paragraph 4 and substituting the following sub-paragraphs:
