CUSTOMS
(MANUFACTURING LICENCE) (EXEMPTION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13(1) of the Customs Act, the Minister for Finance makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Customs (Manufacturing Licence) (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2018 and comes into operation on 24 June 2018.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. Paragraph 2 of the Customs (Manufacturing Licence) (Exemption) Order 2010 (G.N. No. S 305/2010) is amended —

- (a) by deleting sub-paragraphs (b), (d), (g), (h), (i) and (j); and
- (b) by deleting the semi-colon at the end of sub-paragraph (f) and substituting a full-stop.
