# MEDICINES ACT (CHAPTER 176)

# MEDICINES (PROHIBITION OF SALE AND SUPPLY) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Medicines Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Medicines (Prohibition of Sale and Supply) (Amendment) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 September 2019.

## **Amendment of First Schedule**

- **2.** The First Schedule to the Medicines (Prohibition of Sale and Supply) Order (O 4) is amended
  - (a) by deleting item 2 and substituting the following item:
    - "2. Cadmium
- 0.3 part per million."; and
- (b) by deleting the words "20 parts" in item 3 and substituting the words "10 parts".

# Saving and transitional provision

**3.** Despite paragraph 2, any person may, at any time before 1 September 2020, sell or supply any medicinal product which is manufactured or assembled in Singapore, or imported into Singapore, before 1 September 2019.
